

WORLD ROTARACT WEEK 2023

13th MARCH – 19th MARCH

1. The clubs shall celebrate all the 7 days of the week with the motto of celebrating Rotaract on the particular week. The 13th March is observed as World Rotaract day and the day falling on particular week is observed as World Rotaract Week.
2. The clubs also can focus on the Rotary area of focus to conduct the project on the particular days;
 - Peace and conflict prevention/resolution.
 - Disease prevention and treatment.
 - Water and sanitation.
 - Maternal and child health.
 - Basic education and literacy.
 - Economic and community development
 - Supporting the Environment
3. The Clubs can also contribute towards The Rotary Foundation (TRF) by raising fund and club members' contribution.
4. A club receives "Rotaract Giving Certificate" as a whole if they donate \$50 towards TRF inclusive of minimum and maximum of 5 members from the club. (e.g., each member can contribute \$10 where 5 member together it gives \$50).
5. Establish Twin Club Agreement.
6. Create fellowship across the borders by connecting virtually
7. Conduct projects by collaborating with Government Organisations (Police, Revenue & Tax)
8. Celebrate World Rotaract Day – 13th March with your club mates and make them aware on the Rotaract Week Celebration.
9. Conduct a Joint project with Rotary Clubs. (Preferably Parent Rotary)
10. Download World Rotaract Week Celebration Certificate from Rotary International Website and get it approval from the Parent Rotary.
